

Minutes of Annual Meeting of Members of Pine Forest Country Club Community Association, Inc.

The annual meeting of the Members of Pine Forest Country Club Community Association, Inc. ("Association"), a South Carolina nonprofit corporation, was held on January 19, 2010 at 6:00pm at William Reeves Elementary School, 1003 DuBose School Road, Summerville, SC 29483.

Lynn Goettee presented a summary of the Association issues handled during 2009 that included:

1. landscaping completed in the front of the pond
2. landscaping completed at the two rear entrances
3. cleared out the woods to the right of the sign for a better sight line
4. retention ponds and drainage ditches maintained from overgrowth
5. maintained common areas to include grass and shrub trimming
6. updated the main entrance sign and lighting
7. worked with the town and county to improve the drinking water
8. completed a reserve study to validate revenue necessary for reserve fund

Lynn Goettee announced that there are no terms expiring this year so there will be no election at this meeting.

V. Treasurer's Report

Will Russell presented the Treasurer's Report and the proposed budget for 2010 then opened the floor for questions regarding the report and proposed budget. Questions were taken from the floor and answered.

- 16.billing owner/bank for cost of lawn maintenance to foreclosed properties
- 17.clarified that new streets in back of neighborhood are dues paying members of this association
- 18.usage of golf carts by children
- 19.pros and cons of speed bumps on Congressional and Renau
- 20.lighting of the front fountain
- 21.need for letter to county asking for the pavement of the portion of Renau that is outside of Pine Forest
- 22.yard trash being placed on curb days before pick-up
- 23.recent crime in neighborhood
- 24.complaint that the stop signs on Renau are in violation of federal law
- 25.fence to stop children from coming through yard on Carnoustie Ct.
